Errata August 25, 2025 Notice of Changes/Updated Edition

On August 25, 2025, the following changes were implemented in this report. New text is highlighted; deleted text is noted with strikethrough. Hard copies provided, or copies printed from the OAGO website, prior to August 25, 2025 represent the previous version tabled with the Legislature on December 6, 2023.

- **Page 3:** The most recent study from 2016 estimated that the Greater Golden Horseshoe region had reserves of over 3,337 million tonnes of unextracted aggregates in licensed pits and guarries.
- **Page 31:** It also estimated that the region had reserves of over 3,337 million tonnes (545 million tonnes in selected licensed quarries and 2,792 million tonnes in selected licensed pits).
- **Page 32:** As discussed in Section 4.6.1, the Ministry's most recent (2016) supply and demand study appeared to suggest that available supply in the Greater Golden Horseshoe region (over 3,337 million tonnes) was more than adequate to meet demand for the next two decades (2,220 million tonnes). However, the study also estimated that only 1,470 million tonnes (44%) of the total reserves were high-quality, but the Ministry did not publish this information online.
